Who are the parents of Samuel Peters born abt.1821 in Union County, PA?

- John Peters, born in New Jersey, died about 1846 in Union County; and
- Anna Maria, born about 1800 in Germany (1900 Census of son Elias) or PA (1850 Census)

Who are the parents of Mary Ann Swartz?

- More time will be needed for this question to be answered.
- When Jane R. Peters Row's Death Certificate arrives I will send it to you. Such a certificate could help narrow down Mary Ann Swartz's place of birth.

In the interest of brevity and time, I will skip over the details of why I looked at the records I did and how much time I spent on each. Please know that there were many hours spent in pursuit of all leads and the points here were not easy to come by. I will list the key records in the research log with a brief description. I suspect you will find hours of enjoyment in perusing the attached documents in relation to all Peters of Union County. Here I will explain briefly how we can be certain that the above conclusion is correct specifically dealing with your research goal. The attached pedigree and family groups include key sources in order to illustrate the parental relationship and show ages of family members.

- A Samuel Peters was found in an Orphans Court document for a John Peters of Union County.
- The heirs of John Peters, two son-in-laws, a grandson, and widow are given in that record.
- A census search for each of the heirs reveals their ages. A wide range of time between the first and last child with more research, revealed that John Peters had two wives.
- Samuel Peters was found on the grantor/grantee index as he was selling his rights to a piece of land in 1851 in preparation for his move to Dauphin County.
